Apr 11, Wednesday: A day to pamper yourself. Atami-onsen dates back about 1250 years, when hot water springs in the sea were found. Since the high-temperature water with its high salt content has excellent insulation properties, it works well for neuralgia and excessive sensitivity to cold. The water also attracts people who want to tighten their skin and tone their bodies. An ancient document is noted a saying that the first Tokugawa Shogun Leyasu (1543-1616) sojourned here and he even had the water transported to his Edo Castle in Tokyo. *Overnight in Atami*.






